Date: January 24, 2017

Recommendation:

Approve the attached resolution requesting that 100% of all the impact fees from any projects to be built inside the boundaries of I-75 to the east, Florida Turnpike to the north and west and NW 170 Street to the south, stay in Northwest Miami-Dade County to alleviate the impact on regional roads and public services; and that the Town of Miami Lakes receive a percentage of all recurring tax revenue on an annual bases to fund strategic mobility initiatives identified in Attachment "B". In addition, mobility projects identified in Attachment "A" are to be included in the Metropolitan Planning Organization's (MPO) Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP).

Background:

At the January 17, 2017 Regular Council Meeting, Mayor Cid introduced the following new business item for discussion:

I would like to pass a formal resolution requesting that 100% of all the impact fees from the proposed American Dream Mall project stay in Northwest Miami-Dade County, both in the incorporated areas and unincorporated areas, to alleviate the impact on our roads and public services. Additionally, to assist us in dealing with the day-to-day traffic impact, Miami Lakes should receive a percentage of all recurring revenue on a yearly basis to fund our strategic transportation initiatives which will hopefully alleviate the proposed mall's impact for Miami Lakers.

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, REQUESTING ONE HUNDRED PERCENT (100%) OF ALL TRAFFIC **COLLECTED** BY **MIAMI-DADE IMPACT FEES** COUNTY FROM ANY PROJECTS TO BE BUILT INSIDE THE BOUNDARIES OF 1-75 TO THE EAST, THE FLORIDA TURNPIKE TO THE NORTH AND WEST, AND NW 170 STREET TO THE SOUTH, TO BE **ALLOCATED SOLELY FOR INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS** WITHIN **INCORPORATED** UNINCORPORATED AREAS MOST ADJACENT TO **THOSE** PROJECTS, AND LOCATED WITHIN BENEFIT IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT THREE **NORTHWEST MIAMI-DADE COUNTY:** REQUESTING SPECIFIED PROJECTS AS IDENTIFIED IN ATTACHMENT "A", AND AS ADOPTED IN THE **TOWN OF MIAMI** LAKES COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT MASTER PLAN BE INCLUDED IN **MIAMI-DADE COUNTY** METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION'S TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PLAN SO AS TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING PROVIDED THEREBY; REQUESTING A SHARE OF FUTURE TAX REVENUE PAID TO MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AS A RESULT OF ANY PROJECTS TO BE BUILT INSIDE THE BOUNDARIES OF 1-75 TO THE EAST, THE FLORIDA TURNPIKE TO THE NORTH AND WEST, AND NW 170 STREET TO THE SOUTH, BE SHARED WITH THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES TO **AIMED FUND MOBILITY PROJECTS** ALLEVIATING TRAFFIC AS FURTHER DESCRIBED AT ATTAHCMENT "B"; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County Board of County Commissioners is currently considering certain zoning petitions for projects to be built inside the boundaries of I-75 to the east, Florida Turnpike to the north and west and NW 170 Street to the south ("Proposed Projects") which if approved, would result in a regionally significant development located in the northwest portion of the Miami-Dade County, and adjacent to the Town of Miami Lakes; and

WHEREAS, the zoning petitions are for new residential and commercial developments anticipated to be built upon ±537.48 Gross acres and include such facilities as 1,501,000 square feet of entertainment venues, which will include theme parks and an indoor ski slope, a water park, over 4,250,000 square feet of retail space 3,647,200 square feet of office space, and 3,899,738 square feet of warehouse space, new hotels and 2000 residential units; and

WHEREAS, given the scale of the developments, and their likely regional draw, it is anticipated the projects will generate a significant traffic impact to those communities that surround them, including the Town of Miami Lakes and its neighboring unincorporated neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code of Ordinances Chapter 33E, entitled "Road Impact Fee", the projects will be required to pay traffic impact fees as part of any development approval they receive; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Miami-Dade County Code of Ordinances, the allocation of traffic concurrency fees shall only be spent within specified Improvement Districts from where such fees are collected (*see Miami-Dade County Code of Ordinances Section 33E-11*); and

WHEREAS, the Proposed Projects as well as the Town of Miami Lakes are located within Improvement District 3 as identified in Miami-Dade County Code of Ordinances Section 33E11.1; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County Code of Ordinance Section 33E-12 specifies that the expenditure of those collected traffic impact fees are to be used on projects identified by the Miami-Dade County Metropolitan Planning Organization's (MPO), Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP); and

WHEREAS, in order for a local jurisdiction to have qualified projects on the MPO TIP, they must first be adopted within in its Comprehensive Development Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2016, the Town Council of the Town of Miami Lakes amended its Comprehensive Master Development Plan to include several capital improvement projects for transportation and mobility concurrency, and now requests those projects identified in Attachment "A" be included and adopted by the MPO TIP; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Miami Lakes, hereby requests any future tax revenue paid by those developments to Miami-Dade County be shared with the Town of Miami-Lakes so as to be able to fund mobility projects, as described at Attachment "B", which seek to alleviate traffic congestion within the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The above Recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Retention of Traffic Impact Fees.

The Town Council of the Town of Miami Lakes hereby requests that one hundred percent (100%) of the traffic impact fees collected from any projects to be built inside the boundaries of I-75 to the east, Florida Turnpike to the north and west and NW 170 Street to the south be allocated only to those incorporated and unincorporated areas most adjacent thereto to ameliorate any traffic impacts that may result therefrom.

Section 3. Inclusion of Town Adopted Transportation Improvement Projects into the MPO TIP.

The Council of the Town of Miami Lakes hereby requests that projects identified in Attachment "A", be included into the MPO TIP, in order to receive funding.

Section 4. Tax Revenue Share.

The Council of the Town of Miami Lakes hereby requests that any future tax revenue paid by those developments, as referenced herein, to Miami-Dade County be shared with the Town of Miami-Lakes so as to be able to fund mobility projects aimed at alleviating traffic congestion within the Town.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage and adoption by the Town Council.
