They are requested to remain highly visible at the various commercial plazas, apartment and townhome complexes, and hotels in their respective areas. • Current auto theft information as well as BOLOs and Informational flyers are regularly shared with the TML Officers. • Officers continue to investigate Tow Trucks that are operating overnight. • Decoy vehicles continue to be deployed for enhanced visibility. • Comp Details are being scheduled for increased police visibility. • Auto Theft Detectives responded to each car dealership and informed the managers of recent auto theft incidents and ways to improve their procedures. In February and again in March, two vehicles were stolen at car dealerships. The vehicles were left unlocked with keys inside prior to being loaded on trailers for transport.
