On Wednesday, January 8, 2020, at approximately 4:10 pm, GIU Detectives responded to assist uniform officers with a battery incident at White Oak Drive and Miami Lakeway South. Investigation revealed that two students from Miami Lakes K-8 were involved in a fight at a nearby park. One of the juveniles (came from his home) produced a handheld stun gun (electronic device), activated it, and repeatedly battered the other juvenile with it. The subject was subsequently arrested and transported to the JAC. Arrestee: Juvenile W/M (14).
