<i>Location</i>	<i>White Oak Drive / Miami Lakeway South</i>
<i>On Wednesday, January 8, 2020, at approximately 4:10 pm, GIU Detectives responded to assist uniform officers with a battery incident at White Oak Drive and Miami Lakeway South. Investigation revealed that two students from Miami Lakes K-8 were involved in a fight at a nearby park. One of the juveniles (came from his home) produced a handheld stun gun (electronic device), activated it, and repeatedly battered the other juvenile with it. The subject was subsequently arrested and transported to the JAC. <b>Arrestee: Juvenile W/M (14).</b></i>

<i>Location</i>	<i>16400 NW 87 Avenue</i>
<i>On Saturday, January 25, 2020, at approximately 3:00 am, TML GIU Detectives were called out reference numerous vehicle burglary incidents and three subjects being detained. Officers had responded to a call of individuals burglarizing vehicles in the area. As officers arrived they observed a vehicle occupied by three subjects leaving the area. A subsequent stop led to their arrest after video showed the same subjects burglarizing a victim's vehicle located in the area of 16400 NW 87 Avenue. <i>On Sunday, January 26, 2020, at approximately 2:00 pm, Officers responded to the Royal Oaks Park reference an investigation. Contact was made with M. [REDACTED] who advised he was in a dispute with several juveniles who were riding their bicycles and doing wheelies near his vehicle. [REDACTED] stated that he felt he was in fear for his life because the juvenile were surrounding him. A Juvenile Male (17) then approached the officer and advised that M. [REDACTED] had stated that he was going to shoot them and to call the police at which time the juvenile fled for his safety. The juvenile advised that M. [REDACTED] chased him in his vehicle, slammed on the brakes, and then chased him on foot while holding a handgun. M. [REDACTED] was subsequently arrested. <b>Arrestee: E.
