Story from my life,  
describing an experience that demonstrates my character or helped to shape it.

On one of those rare, cold winter days in South Florida, my passion for animals sparked. I was around eight years old when my brother pointed out something from underneath our car. When I went to see what it was, I saw a hopeless, old, small, fragile dog trying to keep warm in the only shelter it could find. All I wanted at that moment was to rescue him just like all the stories I had heard from my mom's childhood of my Abuela rescuing those animals that no one wanted to care for. Because of my mom's fear that his physical condition would leave me heartbroken, she was hesitant about taking him in. In spite of that fear, she welcomed him with open arms, affectionately calling him Mr. Rex because she is as much of an animal lover as me.

Rex became the neighborhood dog as everyone loved and looked out for him. He would leave the neighborhood as he pleased but always returned home. When Rex would leave, I would watch until I could no longer see him in the distance, and I would go out every day after that in hopes to see him return. After a year of taking care of Rex, one day I watched him leave the neighborhood not knowing it would be the last time I would see him. For months, I held on to hope that he would return, and in that time, my heart slowly closed off. I would remind myself how great he was, how he would have spurts of energy where he would become a puppy once again, and how he acted like a charming, respectful old man teaching me new lessons while bringing a smile to my face.

After I lost him, my heart closed off. I was afraid of losing someone else that I deeply cared for. This affected my friendships as I thought it would hurt less if I did not connect with others, but without those connections one cannot grow and flourish. I decided to persevere, and I overcame my fear. I did this by changing my mindset. Instead of thinking of the great loss I suffered, I thought of how I was able to bring love into his life. Rex was in many ways my

inspiration and helped me realize my desire to help animals. Even though my heart had been broken, I did not grow a cynical attitude, and I would help others whenever I had the chance.

My love of animals drove me to volunteer at many farms, and I was able to take those opportunities to impact others in many ways ever since elementary school. One of those being HAPPI Farm, a non-profit organization that used therapeutic horseback riding for autistic and others with disabilities. One might think a farm is just a couple of horses, chickens, and some pigs, but this was an exciting exotic farm. It was filled with arctic foxes, emus, llamas, alpacas, a camel, a water buffalo, caviidae, a donkey and its foal, a tortoise, and a zebra. I fell in love with not only those gorgeous exotic animals, but with the childlike joy that animals bring to those around them.

After seeing the effects of that joy, it motivated me to want to enrich the lives of those animals. This led me to volunteer at farms like F.R.I.E.N.D.S Horse Rescue and Sanctuary, and Peaceful Ridge. At F.R.I.E.N.D.S we bathed, fed, and groomed horses that were in quarantine. These horses could not be adopted out due to the contagion disease to other horses. This farm was their last chance at life, and I was able to bring them some tender love and care while volunteering. Peaceful Ridge rescued horses from neglect, abuse, abandonment, and slaughter. I was able to help by filing the hooves, trimming their mane, bathing, brushing, and bringing donations. I was assigned to help nurture a young mare named Stormy, who was abused by her previous owner with items such as brushes. The goal was to get her to trust again in order to be able to find her a forever home. A couple of years later, I was helping at a ranch and lo and behold there was Stormy. She had recently been adopted by a family, and to my amazement and joy, she had found freedom from her trauma.

While volunteering at Zoo Miami, I found myself to come to a full circle. Whether aiding in taking care of animals or teaching others about the animals' unique characteristics and abilities, it will inspire others to keep the cycle moving forward. One of the greatest moments while volunteering at the zoo was meeting inspiring people such as Ron Magill, a wildlife expert. Magill was able to keep the Harpy Eagle, an animal he loved, from extinction. He was able to accomplish this by teaching the community of Panama to treasure and appreciate the value of this eagle, and now he's inspiring many people, myself included, to continue a chain of finding joy in animals and giving back to them with our love. From taking care of my first dog, Rex, to the exciting experiences and interactions with coworkers and trainers at farms and Zoo Miami, I grew a deeper understanding of compassion. I believe that everyone, animals and people alike, need that same love and compassion in their lives. I see how kindness should affect everything I do, from the way I interact with others at home, work, college and beyond. My only hope is that my life will also be an inspiration to others in the world.
