#### A. Selection of Town Manager and Town Attorney

Town Council to determine if it would be an in-house or outside Town Attorney and if outside counsel, that there will be a need to advertise the RFP.

The Town Attorney, Raul Gastesi, introduced the new telecommunications legislation and legal framework for policy discussions, he spoke about proposed regulations for telecom facilities in the rights of way and in parks.
