A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE USE OF TOWN RESOURCES FOR ANNUAL NATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER ANNUAL SHOE DRIVE AND ANNUAL TOY DRIVE, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, National Day of Prayer, Annual Shoe Drive and Annual Toy Drive may require some Town Resources such as facilities and staff, but are otherwise budget neutral and do not require the expenditure of monies; and

WHEREAS, the Town Manager is desirous of a resolution approving the use of non-monetary Town Resources for the National Day of Prayer, Annual Shoe Drive and Annual Toy Drive on an annual and re-occurring basis; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council agrees that it is in the best interest of the Town to use Town Resources for the National Day of Prayer, Annual Shoe Drive and Annual Toy Drive on annual and re-occurring basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing Recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> Approval of Use of Town Resources. The Town Manager may implement non-monetary Town Resources on an annual and re-occurring basis for the National Day of Prayer, Annual Shoe Drive and Annual Toy Drive without further action from the Town Council.
