## **RESOLUTION NO. 16-\_\_\_\_**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE PURCHASE **OF FENCING INSTALLATION FOR THE DOG RECREATION** AREA AND MINOR FENCING SERVICES AT OTHER SITES ON AN AS NEEDED BASIS; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO UTILIZE THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH CONTRACT 40-11/12 WITH RONALD M. GIBBONS, INC. PURSUANT TO SECTION 7 OF ORDINANCE 12-142 (THE TOWN'S PROCUREMENT ORDINANCE); AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY STEPS TO IMPLEMENT THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO **EXPEND BUDGETED FUNDS; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN** MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE CONTRACT; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR AN **EFFECTIVE DATE.** 

WHEREAS, the Town necessitates the installation of fencing for the dog recreation area

in the amount of \$33,500 and minor fencing services Town-wide on as needed basis; and

WHEREAS, Section 7 of the Town of Miami Lakes Ordinance 12-142 ("the Town's

Procurement Ordinance") authorizes the purchase of goods and services from current contracts

of other public, governmental, state/federal funded or non-profit entities, where the contracts

have resulted from a formal competitive procurement process; and

WHEREAS, the Town intends to access City of Miami Beach Contract 40-11/12 with

Ronald M. Gibbons, Inc. for purchase of the dog recreation area fence installation and minor

fencing services Town-wide on an as-needed basis; and

WHEREAS, the Town Manager recommends authorization to procure fencing services from the current contract between the City of Miami Beach and Ronald M. Gibbons, Inc. for the

dog recreation area in the amount of \$33,500 and for minor fencing services Town-wide not to exceed budgeted funds; and

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MIAMI LAKES, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Recitals</u>. The foregoing Recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Approval of the Contract.</u> The Town Council hereby approves the award of a contract to Ronald M. Gibbons, Inc. in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A" for the dog recreation area fence in the amount of \$33,500 and for as-needed fencing services not to exceed budgeted funds.

Section 3. Authorization of Town Officials. The Town Manager and/or his designee are authorized to take all steps necessary to utilize City of Miami Beach Contract 40-11/12 and to execute said contract on behalf of the Town, subject to approval as to form and legality by the Town Attorney. The Town Manager and/or his designee and the Town Attorney are authorized to take all steps necessary to implement the terms and conditions of the contract with Ronald M. Gibbons, Inc. for the dog recreation area fence in the amount of \$33,500 and for minor fencing services Town-wide per budgeted funds.

Section 4. <u>Authorization of Fund Expenditure</u>. Notwithstanding the limitations imposed upon the Town Manager by the Town's Procurement Ordinance, the Town Manager is authorized to expend budgeted funds to implement the terms and conditions of this Resolution and the contract with Ronald M. Gibbons, Inc. for the dog recreation area fence in the amount of \$33,500 and for minor fencing services Town-wide per budgeted funds.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Execution of the Contract</u>. The Town Manager is authorized to execute the Contract in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A" with Ronald M. Gibbons, Inc. and to execute any required agreements and/or documents to implement the terms and conditions of the contract and to execute any extension and/or amendments to the contract, subject to approval as to form and legality by the Town Attorney.

<u>Section 6.</u> <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption. THIS SPACE INTENTIONALLY LEFT BLANK Passed and adopted this 26<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2016.
