The Town recently celebrated the 40th anniversary of our Miami Lakes Chapter of Zonta International by issuing a proclamation in their honor. During the proclamation event, being true to their mission of advocating for issues affecting women and girls, some of the Zonta members approached me and informed me about an important campaign called "16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence" being undertaken not just by our local Zonta chapter, but all of Zonta International and other international organizations. They asked that the Town of Miami Lakes join with countless other government bodies in lighting their buildings up orange from November 25th to December 10th.

I am sure that my colleagues share my sentiment that women are the cornerstone of our society. We depend on them to create life, to foster family values, and to influence society from the classroom to the boardroom.
