On Wednesday, December 11, 2019, at 12:15 pm, GIU Detectives arrested the second of three subjects of an occupied burglary incident that occurred on September 1, 2019 at 15573 NW 88 Ave. The three subjects had burglarized an unlocked vehicle and the unlocked occupied residence but were interrupted by the homeowner. The subjects fled with the victim's credit cards. Hours later the three subjects utilized the victim's stolen credit cards to make purchases at Walmart and Target stores. Days later, the same subjects were arrested in Boynton Beach for similar charges. The Boynton Beach Detective identified two of the three subjects from video and images our GIU provided. GIU Detectives responded to the Palm Beach Sheriff's Office (PBSO) Main Jail and interviewed the subjects. Two subjects invoked, one subject confessed to his involvement in the TML burglaries. On October 3, 2019, the first subject was arrested after being released from jail. This subject (second subject) was subsequently released from PBSO custody and arrested as he arrived at the Probation and Parole Office in Miami Gardens. He was charged with Occupied Residential Burglary, Vehicle Burglary, Grand theft and Fraudulent Credit Card Use. An arrest warrant will be requested for the third subject still in custody in Palm Beach.

On Friday, December 13, 2019, at approximately 9:00 am, A white male responded to the Town Hall requesting to speak with the Town Mayor. Two Town employees spoke with the white male who brought up an incident where a TML Officer placed him in custody on December 10, near the Casavana Restaurant. During that incident, the white male was Baker Acted. While speaking with the employees, the while male stated that he would kill the TML Officer and or any police officer who ever touched him again. The while male then left the building. The Town employees notified the police at which time a Be On the Lookout was issued. The subject was located and subsequently taken into custody for Threats Against a Public Servant. A search of the white male revealed a .45 cal bullet in his pocket. He claimed that it was only a good luck charm. The while male advised that he is homeless. His last known address is his mother's residence in the Windmill Gate community. The white male is currently in custody.
