Recommendation

It is recommended that the Town Council adopt the attached resolution calling on Miami-Dade County Mayor Carlos A. Gimenez and the Board of County Commissioners to allocate CARES funds to the Town in order to mitigate economic impact felt by COVID-19

Background

On March 27, 2020, the United States Congress passed legislation providing the local governments with populations greater that 500,000 with federal dollars to mitigate the economic impact felt by the COVID-19 health care pandemic. Miami-Dade County was among the 12 government units in Florida that received funds. Specifically, Miami-Dade County received approximately half a billion dollars in relief. The Town and other municipalities, together with the Miami-Dade County League of Cities, are requesting that funds be allocated to assist local governments with the COVID-19 economic impact. Municipalities throughout Miami Dade County have passed or are planning to pass Resolutions urging Miami Dade County to distribute a prorata share (based on population) of CARES Act funds to municipal governments in Miami Dade.
