<p>On Wednesday, June 3, 2020, at 10:15 am, a GIU Detective submitted an additional charge arrest affidavit clearing a burglary to vehicle incident that occurred on February 21, 2019 in the parking lot of the Miller Ale House located at 15251 NW 67<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The victim had returned to his vehicle after having lunch and observed a male subject opening storage compartments of his commercial vehicle. The subject subsequently fled in the passenger seat of Dodge Caravan. Property valued at approximately \$2,000 was stolen. The GIU Detective reviewed previous flyers of individuals involved in similar crimes involving commercial vehicles and identified a possible subject. A photo lineup was presented to the victim who in turn identified the subject. A PC Alert message for the homeless subject was entered. The GIU Detective located the subject who was in custody at TGK on unrelated but similar charges.
