- Train permitting and planning staff on best practices for solar PV.
- Expand and communicate solar finance options for residential and commercial properties.

One of the Objectives of the Town's Adopted Strategic Plan is to "Achieve Universal Environmental Sustainability in Public and Private Environments, Operations and Infrastructure". The Town's commitment to becoming a SolSmart-designated community aligns with this Objective and the Plan's renewable energy initiatives. These efforts demonstrate that our community is committed to driving continual improvement in our solar market, and in the process of doing so, all the related areas identified as community priorities in our Adopted Strategic Plan.
