# **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Town Council adopt the Fiscal Year 2020-21 Budget as amended on second reading and presented in Exhibit A to the Ordinance.

### **CHANGES FROM FIRST READING**

### **BUDGET MESSAGE**

One modification was made to the Town Manager's Budget Message for Fiscal Year 2020-21. Additional language was added to the Fund Balance section stating:

"Barring an unforeseen financial crisis or emergency, the Town's Administration intends to allow the \$238,525 budgeted in the General Fund, under the Contingency Line to flow into Fund Balance at the conclusion of Fiscal Year 2020-21, thereby increasing Fund Balance to 18.3%. This provides an incremental approach of increasing our fund balance annually to get us closer to our mandated goal that equals 20% of our General Fund budget by 2022, as stipulated in Sec. 2-102 (a) of our Code of Ordinances."

### **GENERAL FUND**

One modification was made to the Proposed Fiscal Year 2020-21 General Fund Budget as directed by Town Council at the Council Meeting held on September 15, 2020. The modification is as follows:

• Reallocating Subscriptions and Memberships of \$3,000 from the Economic Development Committee to the Mayor/Council Subscriptions & Membership line item as reflected in the chart below:
